“Agricultural Waste Issues in Wisconsin”

Dr. Rebecca Larsen is an Assistant Professor and Extension Specialist in the Biological Systems Engineering Department at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. She currently works in the area of bio-waste, particularly related to manure and bio-waste handling, processing/treatment, and disposal. She conducts research and outreach for sustainability in agricultural areas concerning biological waste or by-product management including anaerobic digestion, sand and solid liquid separation, manure storage, runoff from manure, manure transport, land application of manure, and feed storage runoff among other areas.

The remainder of the meeting was spent at the National Farm Medicine Center located at the Marshfield Clinic Research Institute. Integrating safety into agri-tourism, promoting ROPS usage, and promoting childcare services for parents who work on farms were a few of the projects he explained. Voluntary enforcement is one of the challenges they face with these projects.
