Dr. Randy Jackson Campbell-Bascom Professor of Grassland Ecology Department of Agronomy – University of Wisconsin



Dr. Jackson is the lead investigator in a new multi-state, multi-institution project to help cut greenhouse gas emissions in the U.S. dairy industry. The project, funded in part through a \$10 million grant seeks to support U.S. dairy's Net Zero Initiative (NZI) as a critical on-farm pathway to advance the industrywide 2050 Environmental Stewardship Goals that were set through the Innovation Center for U.S. Dairy. The funding will support a six-year project – titled "Dairy Soil & Water Regeneration: building soil health to reduce greenhouse gases, improve water quality and enable new economic benefits.
